Foodie Bona Fides

Brookline Boulevard, which already had good food options, welcomed two new additions that give the community some serious credentials as a food destination. Socotra Cafe & Grill and Asahi Ramen celebrated their grand openings and both bring a welcomed change of culture and delicious food to the Boulevard.

Socotra, at 815 Brookline Boulevard, is inspired by its namesake Yemeni island and archipelago located in the Indian Ocean. The restaurant's logo prominently features a Dragon's Blood Tree, a species endemic to the island. Drawing on that uniqueness, Socotra offers a food and coffee menu that promises an experience that blends heritage, connection, and modern flavor.

Asahi Ramen, at 600 Brookline Boulevard (next to the U.S. Post Office), approaches its meals like a true craftsman: carefully selecting each ingredient, slowly simmering the broth, preparing the noodles, and ensuring the timing for it all to come together is perfect. In Japanese, Asahi means morning sun, which the restaurant says is the purest moment of the day, and that spirit lives in each bowl.
